- Format: The New Times Roman style, 14 fonts for title, 12 fonts for text entries and 10 fonts for footnotes with 1.5-line spacing
- Reference: APA Format, 6th Edition
- Authorship: Entries can be co-authored, but limited to maximum three authors per



paper

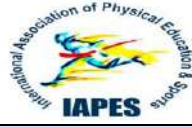
